TREASURER and SECRETARY REPORT

The results this year report a surplus of £4,850, slightly higher than last year. This is attributed Bank Gardens £1,600 and Front Gardens £3,300, increasing each garden's closing reserves to £45,200 and £26,200 respectively.

Overall income of £121,500 is up £5,600 on last year and up £1,500 on budget. The increase on budget is due to £1,125 film location income and £500 donation from Square & Crescent. These were one-offs in the year so contributed to the increase over the previous year. Assessments were up £2,350 and Outside subscriber income and dog registration income both increased £600, all as result of increased rates agreed at the last AGM. Total expenditure of £116,600 compared against last year of £111,700, so up £4,900, but this was expected and budgeted for. The increase was due to some planned larger items and one-offs as follows:

- Painting of Ainslie Place railings £7,100
- Refurbishment of benches £3,100
- Tree survey safety report £590
- Wages and pensions were £58,500, an increase of £3,500 on last year due to 2019/20 being the first full year of increased pension contribution together with inflationary increases in the gardeners pay.

There were some reductions in cost against last year:-

- Maintenance of railings, gates and benches is down £4,000 to £1,800 however this is largely
 presentational as last year included £4,500 painting the railings in the Bank garden whilst this
 year Ainslie Place is shown separately
- Hire & repair of equipment down £1,000 to £2,850 as £1,000 was spent on play bark last year
- Professional fees in relation to the Arches were down £2,100 to £350 for the current year. The previous year had David Narro Associations survey cost.
- Equipment depreciation is £1,500 less as some items became fully depreciated and the major addition (£4,000 on the hand rail in the Bank garden) is written off over 10 years.

Other variations were generally small so within what we would expect to see.

In the Balance Sheet fixed asset additions of £5,000 included the website improvements and a new hand rail in the Bank Garden. Creditor and Debtor movements are small other than an increase in outstanding assessments at the year end which is largely caused by one feuar who is being actively pursued. Cash increased from £32,500 to £38,200 at the year end.

The Committee have developed a budgeted five year maintenance plan which is periodically reviewed and updated. The Summer Newsletter provides an explanation about current finances and the reasons the setting assessment rates for 2020/2021 as follows:-

Front Gardens: 7.45p per £ of 1989 rateable value (previously 6.9p)

Bank Garden: 6.58p per £ of 1989 rateable value (previously 5.1p)

Randolph Crescent: £34.50 per property (previously £32)

Outside subscribers: £227.00 per property (previously £210)

Annual Dog subscription fee: £34.50 per dog (previously £32)

These rates include VAT.
